Short articles, profiles, opinion pieces, political commentary, and other general-interest topics; some articles are condensed from print magazines; contains anecdotes, humor, and a condensed book.

Fiction; child rearing and family relations; home decoration ideas; fashion and beauty hints.

**Reminisce (Bimonthly) REM3**

Articles written by older Americans about experiences and memories from their childhood.

Significant developments in federal agencies, congress, and the courts as they relate to persons with disabilities.

**Saturday Evening Post (Bi-Monthly) SEP3**

A General interest magazine. Contains humor, fiction and non-fiction articles.

First person articles, profiles, opinion pieces, and other general-interest articles. Selections come from Spanish-language magazines as well as the American edition of Reader's Digest.

**Seventeen (Monthly) SVT3**
