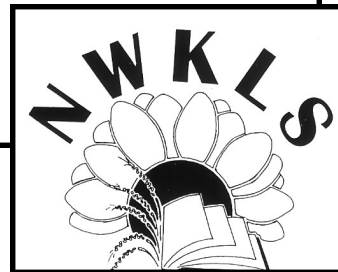


Beat the Heat...Read Workshop
